



DELEGATE INSTRUCTION TECHNIQUES

260Q Flower Instructions

1. Fully inflate a 260Q balloon, release some air to soften, then tie. Tie the two ends of the balloon together to make a loop. Locate the point in the loop directly opposite the knot and twist the balloon at this point to make two bubbles of equal length.

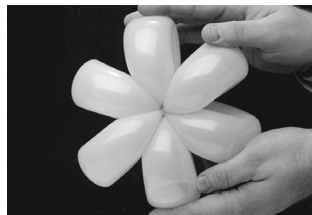
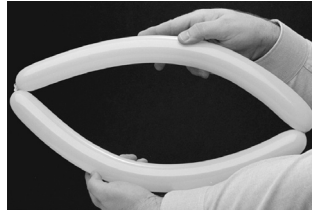
2. Measure one-third of the length from the knot and twist both halves to create two bubbles.

3. Bend the balloon so that the twists from Step 2 meet the knot, then twist the ends of the bubble and the knot together in a figure-8 pattern to create two "loops."

4. Repeat, measuring out from the last twists to create four more bubbles and loops until you have six loops.

5. Arrange the loops as desired to make "petals." Inflate another 260Q and pinch 1" from the end opposite the knot.

6. Deflate the remainder and tie. Place it in the center of the petals and wrap the knot around the petals to secure.
